

March Squares

Larks Foot

It is Spring and I am ready for the birds to come back!! This Larks foot stitch helps me at least hope that the birds will soon return.

Start: Ch 21, turn

Row 1: in 3rd ch from hook dc 1, in next sp dc 1, *ch 1, sk 1,* dc 1 in next three sp** repeat from * to ** up to the end of the row, turn.

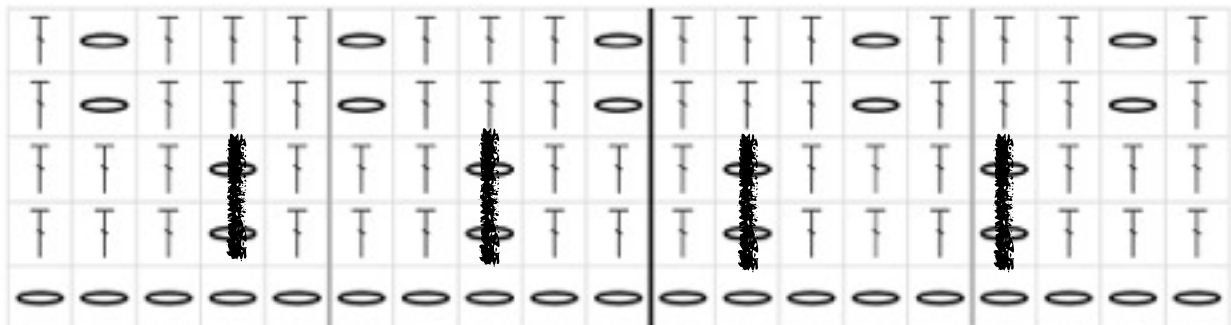
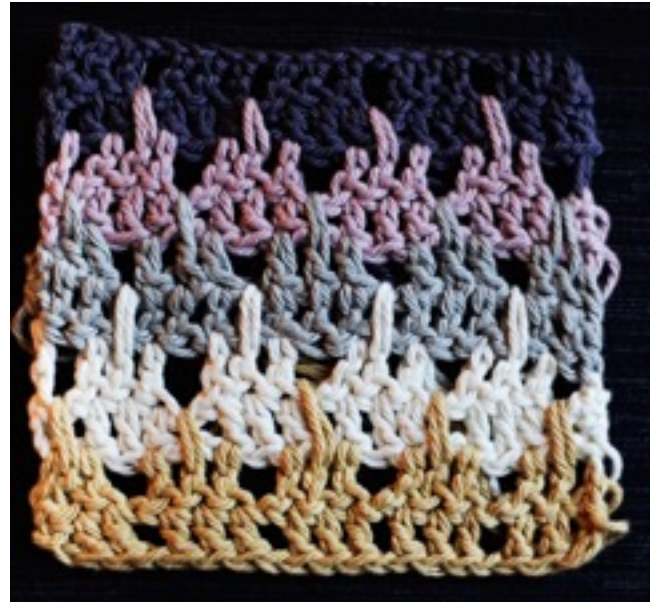
Row 2: ch 2, dc 1 in the next two sp, *ch 1, sk 1, dc 1 in next three sp**, repeat from * to ** to the end of the row.

Row 3: ch3, in 3rd ch from hook, *dc 1, loosely dc down into the sp two rows below, dc 1, ch1, sk 1** repeat from * to ** 3 more times, dc 1, turn.

Row 4: ch3, in 3rd ch from hook, *dc 1 in next 3 sp, ch, sk1, ** repeat across, dc 1 in last st, turn

Row 5: ch 2 in 3rd ch from hook dc 1, in next sp dc 1, *ch 1, sk 1,* dc 1 in next three sp** repeat from * to ** up to the end of the row, turn.

Row 6: ch 2, dc 1 in the next two sp, *ch 1, sk 1, dc 1 in next three sp**, repeat from * to ** to the end of the row.



Stringing Popcorn:

March movies are awesome this year! Why not bring your crochet square and make some popcorn while you eat popcorn!



Start: ch25,

Row 1: sc into the third ch from hook and each ch to end (23 st), turn.

Row 2: ch 1, *dc in top of next st, ch2, skip 1, popcorn st in top of next st.*, repeat from * to ** until two stitches remain. ch 1, dc in next two stitches, turn.

Row 3: ch1, dc in next st, ch 2 skip 1, *dc in next st, ch 2, skip 1, popcorn st, ** repeat from * to ** until 5 st remain. ch 1, sk 1, dc in next st, ch 1 dc in next two st, turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until square is almost 6 inches tall (approx. 9 rows), turn.

Final row: sc across (23 stitches).

Finish: cut yarn, pull through loop and hide ends.
